### **Review**

Last week we learned about the covenant that God made with Abram. What did Abram's name change to? Why did God change Abram's name? What promises did God make to Abraham as part of this new covenant? What was the name of the land that was promised to Abraham and his descendants? Who else in the Bible had their name changed by God?

### **Devotional Thought**

Today's section of text is one of those great passages from the Old Testament where the Lord interacts with great men of faith. We should all long for the day when we can be with our Lord in Heaven!

READ Genesis 18:1-15 - The Lord appears, along with some angels, to Abraham. Abraham obviously recognized who they were and bowed down before them. Abraham, Sarah and their servants quickly set to work preparing a meal for their guests.

The Lord told Abraham that Sarah would have a son even though they were both advanced in year. Sarah laughed at the thought of having a child when she was well past the age of having children and had never been able to have a child before. The Lord even asked her why she laughed.

There are a number of things to talk about or ask questions about in this text. Consider the promise that God was making to Abraham and Sarah, their reaction and our own reactions to God's promise today.

SUMMARIZE Genesis 18:16-33 - The men (angels) leave Abraham and Sarah and set off toward Sodom. The Lord tells Abraham that Sodom had been condemned because of its wickedness. Abraham 'bargains' with the Lord trying to spare the city. What does God think of evil today?

### **Conclusion**

A one page study cannot do justice to this rich chapter in the Bible. Consider breaking this time of worship into two parts for your family. Either way, you will be blessed for looking at the promise of God.
