#### **Getting Started**

#### **Review**

Last week we read about God rescuing Lot and his family from Sodom. What did Lot do when he saw the angels? What did the men of Sodom try to do to the visitors? What offer did Lot make to the angry mob? What did the angels do to the angry mob? What was the reaction of Lot's son-in-laws to the news that the city would be destroyed?

#### **Devotional Thought**

This is yet another story where parents of younger children will need to use discernment in the teaching of the lesson. The destruction of an entire city can be a scary concept for children. Lot's wife turning into a pillar of salt and the indiscretion of his daughters can also be challenging.

READ Genesis 19:15-22 - Why do you think Lot lingered when the angels had already warned him it was time to go? We may often think of Sodom as being an unmerciful event but God obviously showed mercy to Lot since many times he was warned and didn't heed the warning.

READ Genesis 19:23-29 - It is interesting to note that Lot bargained with God to go to Zoar. Once they arrive, the destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah begins. Abraham watches from afar. It is interesting to note verse 29. Do you think this verse implies that God gave Lot special consideration because of his connection with Abraham?

READ Genesis 19:30-38 - This is one of those disturbing passages in the Bible that provide obvious evidence that God has not white-washed the truth of what happened among His people. Where do you think Lot's daughters got the idea that it would be OK to get their father drunk and have sex with him? Quite obviously growing up in Sodom had made its impact on their thinking. How well do you know your Old Testament...what became of the Moabites and Ammonites?

#### **Conclusion**

This was a challenging study but one that was well worth the effort. Ask each member of the family to share something that they learned from this study of the Bible. Close in prayer thanking God for His word.
