### Review

Last week we read about Lot and his family escaping Sodom and what happened after they left. Why did God destroy Sodom and Gomorrah? Why was Lot living near Sodom? Where was Abraham living? Why had they gone separate ways? What can happen to us if we surround ourselves with friends who are doing things they shouldn't be doing? What does God say about the people we are around?

### Devotional Thought

As a family you can decide whether you read all of Genesis 20 or if you just summarize it for your family. This is a short chapter dealing with Abraham and Abimelech.

Abraham once again lies to a King about his relationship with Sarah. They once again say that they are brother and sister instead of husband and wife. Why did Abraham feel like he needed to lie about this? Why do you think Sarah agreed to lie again? Were there consequences for Abraham's lie? What is interesting to note about the consequences of Abraham's lie?

Many times we may be scared and we might tell a lie or a half-truth. Is there a difference between telling a lie and not telling the whole truth? It is important for families with children young and old to consider the importance of being truthful with each other.

As a family, how can it help us if we are honest with each other?

What might happen if we start lying to each other about various things?

As a family, also think about this saying - "The truth hurts." Is the truth sometimes used as a weapon?
