Review

Last week we studied about the promise that God made to Noah, his family and all the generations that would follow. What was the promise that was made? What was the sign of God's promise? How does it make you feel when you see the sign of God's promise all these years later?

Devotional Thought

As we continue looking at the real events recorded in the Bible, we are going to launch into a quick four week study of the book of Ruth. The events recorded in the Bible are not fairytales, they are the real events and challenges that people faced.

READ Ruth 1:1-22

Following are some questions to help your family review what has just been read:

- Where did Naomi move to with her husband and sons? Where was she from?
- What caused them to move?
- Did they pick a good place to move to?
- What happened to Naomi's husband and sons?
- What did Naomi decide she must do?
- Which daughter-in-law went with her and which one stayed behind?
- When they entered Bethlehem what was the reaction of the people?
- What did Naomi tell the people who were excited to see her?
- What time of year was it when they returned to Bethlehem?

Conclusion

For younger families a coloring sheet for the first part of these events has been included. Consider telling the story as younger children color the sheet. Teaching children at any age that the Bible is the record of real events in history is a critical part of belief.
