Review

Last week we studied about Ruth, Naomi and Boaz. We saw a transition in Naomi, how did she change? What advice/guidance did she give Ruth? What was the reaction of Boaz when Ruth acted on the advice of Naomi? Why was it important in their society to have a redeemer? Who is our redeemer today? Why is it important for us to have a redeemer? What issue did Boaz bring to Ruth's attention that kept them from being married? Why was Boaz sleeping on the threshing floor with his Barley?

Devotional Thought

I don't know about you, but I have really been enjoying this short study about the lives of Ruth and Naomi. There is so much to be learned. READ Ruth 4: 1-22.

What a good and unique ending to this great book. Some of the customs of that time are so foreign to us, but I'm sure some of the things we do will look really odd a thousand years from now. Who did Boaz have to find before he could marry Ruth? When Boaz found him, what offer did he extend to the man? Why do you think Boaz didn't mention anything about Ruth in his initial offer? When the man told Boaz that he could redeem Ruth, what did they exchange as a symbol of their deal?

Once they are married, Ruth has a son. What was his name? What was Naomi's reaction? Who took care of the baby? What was the reaction of the people who knew Naomi?

The text says that Obed was the father of Jesse who was the father of David. Who eventually comes form the lineage of David?

Conclusion

Ruth is a great book of the Old Testament. There is so much for us to learn. Have everyone share one thing they learned from Ruth and close in prayer.
