### **Getting Started**

### **Review**

Last week we took a look at the coronation of David as King. This was a big deal! Where did this event take place? Who does the Bible say was present for this event? How many months and years did David reign from Hebron? And how many years and months did David reign from Jerusalem? How many accounts were given of the coronation of David as king? Can you think of any similarities between the crowning of David as king and Jesus Christ?

### **Devotional Thought**

READ 2 Samuel 6:1-15 and 1 Chronicles 13:1-14

The second thing that David did as king was to bring the Ark of the Covenant back into the presence of God's people. (If you want to read about the first thing, check out 2 Samuel 5:17-25. That event would make an interesting second study this week).

How many people did David take with him for this task? Why so many? Where did they go to get the ark? Who was driving the cart that was carrying the ark?

The events from v5-15 can be challenging to talk about with young kids, but provide a clear lesson on obedience and the consequences of disobedience. What was the mood of David at the start of the journey? What happened as they were approaching the threshing floor of Nacon? Why was Uzzah struck dead? Why was David angered and fearful because of this event?

What did David decide to do with the ark after this event? How long did the ark stay in this location? What report did David receive about the ark? What did David decide to do?

### **Conclusion**
