Review

Last week we looked at the end of Ahab. We read through all of 1 Kings 22. Which nation was Ahab king of? Ahab sent for the king of neighbor country. What was the king's name and which country did he reign over?

At one point in our reading the prophet of God was asked for his input on a decision. Who was the prophet and what did he say? What did Ahab say about the guidance the prophet of God provided?

Devotional Thought

READ 2 Kings 2:1-14

If you're looking for a powerful passage about the way God worked directly among His people in the Old Testament, today's devotional should make you happy. Both Elijah and Elisha were well aware that this was the day that Elijah would be taken up to heaven.

How many cities did Elijah and Elisha enter on their journey? In each city what did the people tell Elisha? Did he heed their guidance? Why do you think every one knew what was going to happen to Elijah? Can you think of other events in the Bible that came in a group of three?

Elijah and Elisha arrived at a river. What river was it? What did Elijah do? Elisha made a difficult request of Elijah. What was it? Elijah was taken away by what? Elisha returned to the river with Elijah's cloak and did what?

Concluding Thought

How do you think Elisha felt after witnessing these events? Put yourself in his sandals and really think about it.
