Weekly Theme: Assurance

Verse #1: 1 John 5:13-15

(I use the ESV Bible for these devotionals. Questions are based on that text.)

Jr. Discussion Starter: What is eternal life, confidence, request. What does the passage mean by “if we ask according to His will He hears us”?

Discussion Starter: The words of the Bible are written so that we may know that eternal life is ours. How can we know this?

Verse #2: John 3:16-17

Jr. Discussion Starter: What do the words believe, perish, and condemn mean? How does God sending Jesus show His love for us?

Discussion Starter: This is probably the best known scripture in the New Testament. How does God’s sacrifice show His love for us? Why couldn’t God do this in another way? Does God want all people to be saved? Can you find a verse that says that? Will everyone be saved? Why won’t everyone be saved?

Verse #3: 1 John 5:11-12

Jr. Discussion Starter: We looked at 13-15 of this chapter earlier this week, what did they say? What do these verses add to the meaning of this passage? Why is it important to know Jesus? How do we get to know Him?

Discussion Starter: What testimony are you giving with your day to day life? Do you live a life that shows the assurance that you have of salvation? Or are you living in a way that shows you doubt in God and His promise?

Verse #4: 1 John 2:1-2

Jr. Discussion Starter: What do these words mean - sin, advocate, righteous, propitiation? How does it help us to know that God will forgive us when we do wrong?

Discussion Starter: Why does the author address this message to “my little children”? How do the things written in 1 John help us to not sin? How does it help you to know that God is willing to forgive our mistakes? Have you asked forgiveness of yours sins lately?

Verse #5: 1 John 2:3-6

Jr. Discussion Starter: What do these words mean—commandments, liar, perfected, abides. Can you tell me what this passage means?

Discussion Starter: How does keeping His commandments show that we know God? Are there a lot of people who claim to know God but don’t follow His commandments? How do we avoid being what the text refers to as a “liar”?
